CHRISTINE SUN KIM'S DRAWINGS act out a form of sociology, dressing up the artist's point of view as a data set. 

In so much of our shared space, including environments in the cultural sphere, hearing is taken for granted. Kim's images point out the obviousness of what is very often overlooked by hearing people. But some efforts by institutions to broaden access across the audial speccises, much like the racial-diversity initiatives that might attempt to smooth out barriers to entry but all enable, well, ableism. In these informative charts, Kim affirms that feelings are facts.






